REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for LCSW-S status, you must have had your LCSW license for a minimum of two years (**cumulative, in any state**, but must be a Texas LCSW for -S status). **YOU CAN TAKE THE COURSE EARLY.**

Attendees that meet criteria and complete the course can apply for Supervisor (LCSW-S) status immediately.
